• Li Li wins Margaret Chalmers Memorial \$3,000 Scholarship

Li entered this instrumentalist scholarship competition on the Accordion and had to perform two pieces of contrasting styles in the 2009 MTA Scholarships Showcase Concert on Sunday, 30 Aug 09 at the Coote Theatre, Scots College, Bellevue Hill. Li's category was of an extremely high standard of competition and included some brilliant instrumentalists. There was such a buzz around the theatre when Li got onto the stage with the accordion. The audience and the three distinguished judges were amazed at Li's standard of performance. Needless to say she received a rapturous round of applause. It was a wonderful afternoon of musical entertainment featuring some of the finest young musicians, including pianists, cellists, flautists and contemporary and operatic vocalists, who competed for some outstanding prize money. Li took out the largest prize by far for a solo performance. What fantastic exposure this was for the accordion.

The afternoon was judged by the Patron and internationally renowned conductor, Patrick Thomas MBE, along with the Dean of the Sydney Conservatorium, Professor Kim Walker and Head of Vocal Studies at The King's School, Mrs Karen Walmsley. The Concert also featured guest artists Diana Doherty and Warwick Adeney. Diana is the Principal Oboist with the Sydney Symphony Orchestra and has performed extensively around the world. Warwick is a concertmaster of the Queensland Symphony Orchestra and one of Australia's leading violinists.

Li is preparing to sit for her AMusA diploma on the Piano this year and has already completed her AMusA on the Accordion with Distinction. She works full time as a pharmacist and has recently completed her pharmacy exams, not to mention, she sat for the Sydney University medicine entrance exam which she is

feeling very confident about. A very multi-talented and determined young lady. We wish her every success in the future everything she does.

A couple of weekends ago I held an Impromptu Farewell Concert at the studio for one of my students who is moving to Dubai for a couple of years with his family.
