This years event promises to be most interesting accordion happening with competitors coming from: New Zealand, Australia, China and Russia.

The 2nd International Accordion Competition "AKORDEON ART" was held in Sarajevo (Bosna and Hercegovina) from 27.4.~30.4.2011. Campbell Thwaites of NZ, student of Tania Lukic-Marx, represented NZ and received the 2nd Prize. Campbell's performance and presentation at this event was to be proud of.

Competition was extremely well organized and well attended. Competition Director, well known Serbian accordion tutor: Zoran Rakic and his team have done a wonderful job at organizing this international event. There was 226 competitors in 9 age categories, from: Serbia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, New Zealand, Lithuania, Macedonia, Slovenia, Montenegro, Hungary, Bulgaria. Jury was truly international, and the following countries were represented: Serbia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, New Zealand, Lithuania, Macedonia, Australia, Ukraine, Finland, Bulgaria, and Russia. There was in total 36 adjudicators (4 per each category). Tania Lukic-Marx and Mylie Thwaites were invited to represent Australia and New Zealand as adjudicators.

Guest Artists at the event included outstanding accordion soloists: Vladislav Pligovka, Aleksandar Skliarov, Vladimir Zubicky, Zoran Bozanic, the Choir and the Accordion Orchestra of the Music Academy in East Sarajevo.

The event was a truly amazing musical experience, and probably one of the biggest and best organized international accordion competitions in the Balkans.
